FIRE PREVENTION 1B



Fire Prevention 1B “Inspection of Fire Protection Systems and Special Hazards” is the second of three courses required to become certified by the California State Fire Marshal (CSFM) as a “Fire Prevention Officer” and one of eleven courses needed to obtain the CSFM “Fire Officer” certification. Specifically, Fire Prevention 1B is a 40-hour course that provides information regarding flammable liquids, combustible liquids, hazardous materials, explosives, fire extinguishers, detection systems, alarm systems, and special fixed fire alarm systems. This course accommodates platoon-duty schedules; therefore, students need only attend one date under each session. Students will receive 2 lower division college units accredited by the California State University System.
