You are the Task Force Commander assigned to Fire Station 74. It is late November. It has been raining moderately for the past three days. At approximately 0300 hours, Task Force 74 is dispatched to the intersection (fictitious) of Hill Street and Pine St. The recent Station Fire left thousands of acres of “scorched earth” hillsides vulnerable to the winter rains. There have been no significant rain related incidents in the last 24 hours.

Enroute, visibility conditions are hampered by the strong rains. Approximately one block from the incident, you are forced to park the apparatus due to severe street flooding. You decide to approach the incident on foot with the Captain I and the Apparatus Operator. Once onscene you discover a severe landslide that has critically impacted two houses. Bystanders report several people are trapped.

Both houses have steep hillsides behind them. Soil and stability conditions are unknown.

### Captain Guidelines

- What FD resources will you request?
- What direction will you give the CI and the AO?
- What initial actions could your crew accomplish at this type of incident?.
- What outside agencies will you request?
