You are the Captain I assigned to Fire Station 20. It is Saturday morning. At approximately 0200 hours, Engine 6, RA 6, Task Force 20, RA 20, Light Force 11, Engine 13 and Battalion 11 are dispatched to a reported structure fire at 136 S. Virgil. When E6 arrives on scene they report a large, 3-story apartment house, with fire showing from two windows on the third floor. You remember this particular building from a “pre-fire” walk-thru.

The building is a newer, three story, center hallway, apartment building with many fire doors. The water system consists of a wet standpipe and 1 1/2” outlets with hose that is primarily intended for building occupant use. While enroute to the incident, you can hear over the TAC channel that E6 is having difficulty locating the fire unit. After the delay, E6 locates the unit and reports that two rooms are well involved.

As TF 20 approaches the incident, E6 directs E20 to perform “back up fire attack”. Truck 20 will be performing ventilation.
