

TACTICAL DECISION GAMES

Incident Commander Solution Worksheet

Initial Considerations:

Ensure firefighter safety.

Rescue of people on the 3rd floor balconies.

Protect the exposures above and beside the involved 3rd floor unit.

Extinguish the fire.

Evacuate residents.

Provide for displaced residents.

Place remainder of 1st alarm assignment:

BC 11 – Incident Commander

TF 29 – Truck 29 to roof, E 29 is fire attack on 3rd floor

LF 11 – Interior truck work on 3rd floor

E 13 – RIC

E 6 – Assist fire attack on 3rd floor

EMS 11 – Medical Group Supervisor

RA 11 - Triage

Place Additional Resources:

BC 1 – Division 3

BC 2 – Logistic Section Chief

TF 1 – Evacuation Group

TF 2 – Division 4

RA 1 – Med. Comm.

RA 2 – Litter team / treatment

RA 3 – Litter team / treatment

Your Actions:

I would activate E13 RIC team to locate the separated nozzle firefighter from E 29, possibly on the 3rd floor.

I would immediately call for PD to act as crowd control and to detain any suspects.

I would make sure Arson was notified.

Notify Red Cross for possible displaced residents.

Identify an adequate area to organize the MCI portion of the incident.

Secure the scene including witnesses and suspects.

Try to keep the fire contained in the 1 involved 3rd floor unit.

Secure a safe stairwell for civilian egress and another stairwell for firefighting operations.
