TRENCH RESCUE



observe a large group of parents next to the trench. They are shouting instructions down into the trench. The trench is approximately 50' long. It is 12' feet deep and 5' in width. The victim is a nine year old boy and is buried up to his chest. His face and one arm are visible. He is semi-conscious.

You are the Captain assigned to E96. Light Force 96 was dispatched on “wires down” about 10 minutes ago. It is a Fall day with temperatures in the high 60’s. E96 is dispatched from quarters on a “man down”. The area that you are responding to is comprised of large single family dwellings on 1/2 acre size lots. As you arrive on scene you observe many people in front of the

incident address. There is a large group of parents and their children who are visibly upset. You are informed that there is a trench behind the incident address. Parents state that it caved in and that that there were 3 children playing in it. Two of the children have been rescued from the trench and have sustained minor injuries. As you enter the backyard you
