DECONTAMINATION



You are the Captain II assigned to Task Force 75. Your Task Force is picking up equipment from a “food on the stove” incident and are minutes away from becoming available. A frantic citizen pulls his car along side Truck 75 and informs you that an explosion just happened at the market around the corner. It is approximately 1030 hours on a Sunday morning. Wind is non-existent and temperature is about 70 degrees. You notify OCD that Task Force 75 is available and

responding to an explosion in a market at Devonshire and Sepulveda. As you arrive onscene you observe that the parking lot is very crowded with vehicular traffic. The market looks to be intact with no fire involvement. There appears to be a light haze coming from somewhere behind the market. You direct Engine 75 to investigate the situation. Light Force 75 is spotted out Devonshire Street. Civilian vehicular traffic is continuing to enter and exit the market

lot through multiple driveways. Engine 75 reports that a small explosion occurred inside the market near the rear. There is no fire involvement inside the market. Engine 75 also states that there are approximately 10 people with various minor injuries and they are escorting them outside. You notice many people demonstrating obvious signs of “SLUDGE”.
