You are the Captain II assigned to T37. E71, TF37, RA 37, E59, LF92, EMS 9 and Battalion 11 are dispatched to a reported structure fire at 10401 Wilshire Blvd. This building is an 11 story residential high rise constructed in 1951. You observe fire showing from the 9th floor on the south side of the building. It is lapping up to the 10th floor. It is 0645 hours on a Saturday. You are the IC and you give the following assignments:

E71— Fire Attack,  
E37— Floor Above,  
E59—Back Up Fire Attack, LF 92—Inside Truck Work on the 9th Floor. You order 4 Task Forces, 4 Engines, 2 RA's and 3 BC's. Engine 237 begins to load the standpipes on the south side of the building. T37 members take Lobby and you remain on T37 as the IC. E71 reaches the fire floor and states that they have one room well involved on the 9th floor and the fire has extended into the

hallway. E71 utilizes a standpipe in the stairwell in order to develop a firefighting line. Within minutes E71 frantically states that there is no water in the standpipe.

### Captain Guidelines

- What type of water system is in this building?
- Identify additional ways of supplying the system
- Identify additional ways of developing a firefighting line on the 9th floor
