You are a Firefighter assigned to E209. Your Engine Company is pre-deployed to FS 82. It is the second day of a strong Santa Ana wind condition in mid-September. Temperatures have hovered in the “high” 90’s for the last few days. Humidity is less than 10% today. Engine 209 is dispatched with a “brush assignment” up into the Hollywood Hills on a brush fire. As you head north from FS 82, you immediately observe a brush fire

in the hills directly threatening structures. E209 arrives at the incident address. The Captain directs you and the other FF to “pull” an 1 1/2” hose line to the back of the structure. It is becoming very dark due to the smoke from the brush fire. You and the other FF work together to bring the hose line from E209 to a side gate entrance. You discover that the gate is locked. This slows you down, but you are able to force the gate open

and proceed thru. You are within 25’ of heavy brush on this side of the house. You continue thru and pass by a pool. The homeowners are not home. The house has extensive glass windows on the backside. As you near the back property line, you realize that the fire has “erupted” and you are about to get “overrun”.
