You are a Firefighter assigned to Engine 63. It is late October and a mild Santa Ana condition exists. Temperatures hover in the mid-90's. It is approximately 0900 hours. E63 is in quarters when it is dispatched to Fire Station 88 to form a Strike Team. There is heavy traffic on the freeway and you arrive at FS 88 an hour later. Your Captain meets with the Strike Team Leader for approximately 30 minutes before the Strike Team leaves

for FS 88. Thirty minutes later your Strike Team is enroute to Santa Ynez. Approximately 3 hours later you arrive at base camp in Santa Ynez. When you exit the apparatus you notice that temperatures have increased. Wind speed has also increase. You are in Base Camp for only 10 minutes when your Strike Team receives orders for structure protection. E63 follows the Strike Team Leader and gets an assignment to protect two structures.
