You are the TFC assigned to Fire Station 58. It is 0200 hours on a Sunday morning. Your Task Force is dispatched as part of a second alarm to a working high-rise fire in Fire Station 71’s district. You listen to the Tac channel while enroute and companies onscene report a 15 story residential high-rise with fire in one unit on the 7th floor. You report to “Base” once onscene and are immediately given the assignment of “Truck Work” on the 9th floor. Members of

your Task Force suit up and report to “Lobby”. You are directed to stairwell #1 to begin your ascent. E59 is currently assigned as Division 9. You hear the IC state that the fire has broken out of a window on the 7th floor and is lapping up the side of the building. Division 8 reports heavy smoke on the floor above the fire. You and your Task Force bypass staging on the 5th floor. You begin to smell smoke in the stairwell on the 6th floor. When you arrive

on the 9th floor, Division 9 informs you of medium smoke conditions and that there are approximately 7 Senior Citizens who need to be evacuated from their units.

### TFC Guidelines

- Define “Truck Work” on the 9th floor
- What assistance will you need with the evacuation?
- What equipment will you need to assist with the evacuation?
- Who do you report to and where will you evacuate the Senior Citizens?
