You are the Apparatus Operator assigned to Fire Station 72. Your “Top Member” is a first-house probationary firefighter. Your “Tiller Member” has 2 years on the job. You have trained extensively with the Tiller Member on roof ventilation SOG’s. At 0200 hours Task Force 72 is part of a structure fire assignment to Topanga Canyon Blvd. and Hart Street. Task Force 72 arrives onscene first and finds a 75’ x 50’ one story new commercial building. Heavy smoke is

issuing out of all of the windows. You recognize this building from a recent “pre-fire”. Roof construction consists of light weight open web construction. The building is laddered properly and you lead the roof team up a ground ladder. You survey the roof before stepping off the ladder. Fire has not broken through and there is no visible sagging. Engine 72 reports heavy smoke conditions inside and is requesting ventilation as soon as possible.

You step onto the roof and are followed by the other two truck firefighters.

### AO Guidelines

- Discuss what equipment is brought to the roof.
- Discuss the operation that must be accomplished when stepping off the ladder
- Discuss order of personnel enroute to ventilation hole
- Discuss members individual responsibilities
- Discuss safety member responsibilities
