You are a Captain I assigned to Fire Station 93. It is approximately 1200 hours. Engine 93 is performing fire prevention inspections on Ventura Boulevard. The boulevard is crowded with both vehicular and foot traffic. Temperatures are hovering around 100 degrees. Your nozzle member is a first-house probationary firefighter. Your hydrant member and Engineer are both veterans.

Engine 93 and Rescue 93 are dispatched to a “traffic” on Ventura Boulevard. Both units arrive onscene at the same time. You observe that two cars were involved in the accident. One of the vehicles is still on the boulevard. The other vehicle crashed into the sidewalk restaurant pictured above. There are many civilian injuries due to the car coming up onto the sidewalk. The vehicle in the street has

sustained passenger space intrusion on the driver side. There does not appear to be a fuel problem.
