You are the Captain II assigned to Task Force 75. It is approximately 0400 hours on a Wednesday. Engine 91, Engine 18, RA891, Task Force 75, EMS12, Batt. 12, LACO Squad 73 and LACO Engine 126 are dispatched to a tanker fire. The incident is located inside Los Angeles City limits. It is in the southbound 5 freeway truck lane tunnel. E91 arrives on scene and reports a large

fire inside the truck tunnel under the 5 freeway (see photo above). E91 requests additional resources including two foam carriers. The PR on scene reports that he is the driver of the gasoline tanker on fire and he was the only vehicle involved in the accident and there are no injuries. BC12 arrives on scene and confirms E91's size up. BC12 directs Task Force 75 to

provide water to the south end of the tunnel. The only hydrant in proximity is on San Fernando Road approximately 1200' away. A set of train tracks are located between San Fernando Road and the 5 freeway.

- Identify 3 methods of supplying water to the south end of the tunnel.
- What communications must be made with outside agencies?
