TDG #5 Solution Worksheet

Fire Ground Considerations:

1. Being 0200 hours, you could have a rescue problem, as well as people in the hallway affecting your operation.
2. Bringing a line up the exterior stairwell and then the interior stairwell could be difficult, time consuming, and labor intensive with just 3 firefighters.

2nd Floor Company Actions:

Have residents shut their doors and shelter in place.

1. Close door to unit 214 and proceed to unit 215 (the adjacent unit). Confirm unit 215 is not involved with fire.
2. Establish a drop bag line inside unit 215, behind a closed door for safety.
3. Proceed back into the hallway, check for extension above you in the hallway (probably not due to joist/rafter construction).
4. Enter unit 215 and extinguish the fire.
5. Conduct a primary search.
6. Check for extension in the ceiling/floor above and in the wall facing the exterior.

Radio Communications

1. I.C. from truck 72 we have heavy smoke inside unit 214 with light smoke in the hallway on the 2nd floor. We are going to unit 215 to establish a drop bag line. Have the next truck company throw a ladder to our drop bag line.
2. I.C. from Truck 72 we are entering unit 214 with heavy smoke, there is no extension into the hallway.

3. I.C. from Truck 72 we have a knock down in unit 214. We are conducting a primary search and checking for extension. We need blowers set up in the stairwell to clear the hallway and the unit.
4. I.C. from Truck 72 primary search is clear and there appears to be no extension.
