TDG #5 Solution Worksheet

Fire Ground Considerations:

Due to location, occupancy type, and time of day I can assume there will be a high probability of occupants possibly trapped.

- Crew experience
- Appropriate PPE, forcible entry equipment
- Appropriate Tach Channel
- Possible extension
- Fire protection systems (if any) / operable?
- Forcible entry challenges
- Exposures
- Hazards both on the roof and possibly inside structure
- Need for additional companies
- Rescue needs/ operations

2nd Floor Company Actions:

- determine the need for ventilation (non needed)
- open the penthouse door for ventilation / evacuation
- proceed to the 2nd floor notifying the IC of the conditions
- notify IC of the moderate/ heavy smoke conditions
- notify E72 (engineer) of a drop bag operation from 2nd fl.
- pull up appropriate amount of 1 3/4" into unaffected area of hallway/ stairwell.
- advance the line through the stairwell door toward the affected area
- perform primary search and determine the extent of the fire along the way.
- IC will be notified of conditions and if victims are found during the process.

- If there is fire extension on the 2nd floor, T72 will attempt to knock down the fire with a coordinated effort from E72 on the first floor.
- If there is no extension, T72 will ventilate the hallway and do a primary search.
- Incoming companies will be assigned to search and rescue, back up fire attack, ventilation and salvage.
- After knock down, T72 will check for extension, extinguish and begin assisting with ventilation and salvage.
