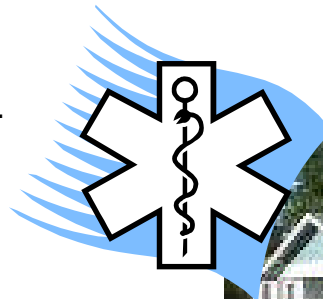

SHOOTING

Situation

You are assigned to Paramedic Rescue 10. Since you have five more years of experience than your partner, you are in the lead position. It is a warm summer afternoon. It is approximately 1600 hours when your ambulance is dispatched to a shooting at 502 E. 22nd street. The dispatch information indicates multiple wounds. Your engine company was dispatched on a rubbish fire, so you are getting another engine company from an adjacent district. You are the first fire dept. unit onscene. You approach with caution to ensure that the police dept. has secured the scene. As you arrive on the street, a police unit waves you in. As you drive down the street you note that the address is a single family dwelling.



The police officer waves your unit to a parking spot in front of the house. As you pull up, you note there are many civilian vehicles parked in front of the house. Many frantic civilians are running around in the street crying and screaming. It appears that some kind of party was going on. There are two police units onscene with officers in front of the residence and some officers on the front porch. The house is a single story residence with the front yard enclosed by a chain link fence. As you get out of your rescue, you see three

victims lying on the grass in front of the house and another victim is sitting on the porch with blood on his chest. The officer on the porch sees you and yells that there are two more victims inside the house. As you walk up to the yard, someone yells at you that one of the victims on the grass just stopped breathing.
