

TDG Shooting

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1. Initial considerations

- a) Personal safety...Don vest and make sure radios are operational
- b) Consider shutting down siren prior to arrival @ incident
- c) Confirm with PD it is safe to enter incident (is scene secure?)

Are suspects gone?

- d) Consider access and egress at incident

2. On-scene arrival

- a) Communicate with PD that scene is safe before entering.
- b) Make sure PD is setting up a perimeter to keep bystanders at bay.
- c) Will any vehicles cause problems for arriving units or for pt. care considerations?

3. Lead paramedic decisions

- a) Get out MCI organizational packet and ensure partner has MCI tags.
- b) Have partner initiate triage of pts. and get report from him on #'s and status.
- c) Notify OCD of need to additional resources and where to enter incident location.
- d) Open communication with MAC

4. Resources needed at scene

- a) B/C
- b) 2 EMS supervisors
- c) 1 Task Force and 4 engines
- d) 6 ALS rescues if all victims are critical

5. Primary critical actions

- a) Triage pts. using START system.
- b) Report triage results to lead paramedic
- c) C-spine immobilization for any GSW's to the trunk
- d) Coordinate with MAC to transport pts to most appropriate facilities for injuries.
