Physical Rescue Solution Worksheet

Incident Considerations:

- Experience of crew (Rookie)
- Weather
- Knowledge of district/location (response route)
- Time of day/day of week (Weekday/Weekend)

Task Force Member Responsibilities:

As the Commander of Task Force 2 assigned to a Physical Rescue assignment on a major freeway my overall objective is to extricate the victims as rapidly as possible with safety being the biggest factor. I would know that all members are properly trained in comp. SOG's and on the appropriate tac channel. I would know that all equipment and apparatus are in proper condition and ready to respond with all response routes open. I would also assume command until properly relieved.

Upon arrival En. 202 would shut down the transitional road at the NB 5 Fwy till relieved by CHP. My size up would be, "OCD from TF 2, We have two vehicles involved with one rollover. Give me one additional BC, two Task Forces, 5 ALS RA's and 3 BLS. Also notify CHP that we have shut down the transition at the NB 5 and they'll need to assist".

First Alarm assignment

Truck 2 – Extrication of 3 patients with PSI

Capt. II - IC till relieved, size-up, scene safety

set up staging for fire resources past the incident,

and ra's before the incident in #2 lane

- A/O - scene size-up, operate cutters/jaws
- Tiller - assist A/O, bring power unit jaws
- Top - bring power unit and cutters, operate power unit
- Inside - cribbing, lighting, additional equipment

Engine 2

- Capt. I - Safety/Pt. Care
- Eng. - Pump panel/safety
- Hydrant - Pt. Care
- Nozzle - 1 ½ hoseline dry chem. Extinguisher

RA 2

- Driver - Set up communications with MAC
- Attend. - Implement S.T.A.R.T. System

Light Force 4 – Assigned to van

- Capt. II - scene safety
- A/O - scene size-up, operate cutters/jaws
- Tiller - assist A/O, bring power unit jaws
- Top - bring power unit and cutters, operate power unit
- Inside - cribbing, lighting, additional equipment

Engine 4

- Capt. I - Safety/Pt. Care
- Eng. - Pump panel/safety
- Hydrant - Pt. Care
- Nozzle - 1 ½ hoseline dry chem. Extinguisher

Engine 204

- Eng. - Aerial over incident for lighting if needed,
additional tools/equipment

Battalion 7 - IC upon Arrival, scene size-up

EMS 7 - Ambulance staging

HR 56 - Continue through till not needed and have spot in front of incident if needed.
